

Electrical Parts

Lift trucks may be purposely marked to be used in unsafe locations. A labeled forklift indicates the design has met the minimum requirements of ANSI/UL 558 for engine powered forklifts or ANSI/UL 583 for electric trucks for the type of label placed.

The use for labels for lift trucks can be found in National Fire Protection Association NFPA 505 - Powered Industrial lift trucks including: Maintenance and Operation, Type Designations, and Areas of Use. Ask your local insurance carrier and Fire Marshall for more info concerning the permitted uses of industrial powered trucks in your application.

If the particular lift truck satisfies the outlined criteria, labels can be placed. A labeled forklift will show the type of designation placed on the nameplate and would have a correctly corresponding label placed.
